#### 12. New Business:

- Review Executive Travel Expense criteria-Mary Holley-Comes out of general account. Egon Sandau motioned we conform with gaming regulations to have funding start at 100km, 25Cents a km, 1 claim per household/vehicle. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jane Cordingley. Carried.
- Zone Director's Duties-Mike Holley-In By-Laws. Can be assisted/clarified by Mike, if needed.
- Resolution to Horseshoe Canada-Winnona Kilbourn motioned that the # of Shoes to be pitched be 200 Per Day for all adult shoe limit games. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Lyle Olmstead. Carried. Dianne Beck to send to Horseshoe Canada.



- Pre-Registrations for Tournaments-Dianne Beck-All major tournaments in Alberta as well as all Calgary are to be pre-registered and the money is needed by registration date. Mailing times can be extended now in some areas, please phone Dianne if mailing payment. Scorekeepers are needed all day, please keep this in mind when leaving tournament early.
- Alternate Pitching Times for Major Tournaments-Winnona Kilbourn-Discussion regarding players playing alternate times in a two day tournament. A Players play points which can extend the day and their classes are usually scheduled in the afternoon. As there are other factors to consider, it is not always feasible to do this. Let Dianne / tournament director know if someone needs to be at another important function. She may be able to accommodate you. This is up to the tournament director.
- Review Criteria for Sportsman of the Year Award-Jackie Olmstead-criteria for this award to be worked on. Dates for nominations for Volunteer, Media and Builders awards need to be in earlier as AGM is earlier now. To be August 15. Hall of Fame need to be in by June 15.
- First Aid should be available for every sanctioned tournament-Mike Holley- Does not have to be major for smaller tournaments, however, minor supplies are needed and, if possible, should have a person there with first aid certificate/experience.
- Sanctioned Tournament Format-Mike Holley - Rules for tournaments have been clarified, were in 2014 Spring newsletter. Per Horseshoe Canada, peeeweas are to pitch from 20ft. and only 30 shoes per game. We are a professional organization and as such our rules need to apply to all tournaments-cancellation applies and no alternate pitch or count all are to be used. League play is different.
- Zone 4-Portable Courts-Mary Holley - Need to sell for \$600/set. Price of making new sets is \$194 plus GST for just the plastic parts for each end plus cost for steel and mounting brackets. Mould and first 20 sets of courts were purchased from gaming funds. Need to replace 5, using general account, to bring back to inventory of 20. Mary to find out if it would cheaper if larger quantity is ordered. Form for renting needs to be updated.
- Zone 4-Newsletter on Website-Winnona Kilbourn-Not all members have computer access. In future, newsletter and other forms including agenda will be on website as mailing costs are getting quite high. Clubs can print these for new members or those needing a paper copy without computer access.
- Zone 4 Volunteer Award-Mike Holley-This is not provincial so should not be presented at AGM
- Zone 4 Advertising for Canadians-Winnona Kilbourn-they had requested and paid for ¼ page ad in program. They were on donors sign only. This was unfortunately missed due to paper trail. No refund is needed.

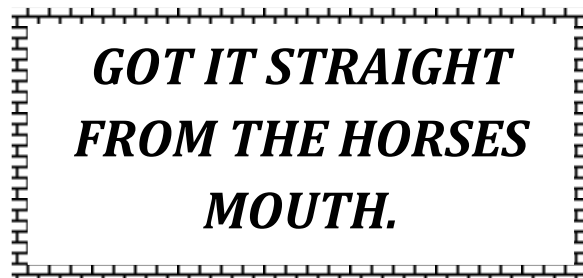

# Alberta Sports Connection

October 4, 2014

Hello folks. After playing telephone, email, and mail tag for a few weeks in March, ASPRWF informed us that they received all of the required paperwork and signatures, enabling us to receive our grant. During this past spring, ASPRWF underwent many changes. These included numerous changes of contact and last, but not least, development of a new logo to place onto documents. It is much easier to type ASC than ASPRWF! If you are wondering what the new logo looks like, you will see I up in the corner on the new membership forms. The Chair of ASC placed a message in our Canadian Handbook when Alberta hosted the Canadian Horseshoe Championships this past summer.

By the end of March, our association was required to submit a 3-5 year strategic plan. This plan basically entails what our association is, who belongs to it, how we operate, what our future plans are and how the association will strive to meet all the elements of this plan. Without the assistance of my committee members, Hazel Heistad and Linda Skiehar, this detailed plan would not have evolved. Thanks for all your hard work ladies.

As chair of this committee, a few weeks ago I received by email the new survey to be completed by March 1, 2015. As usual, many of the questions are different than those from last year so don't be surprised if I contact some of you for information. Now that I have the survey to complete, I imagine I will shortly receive the biggie----the document whereby our association completes pre and post analysis sheets for each of our items of revenue and of expenditure. This works out to roughly 80 forms by the time this is completed. In addition to forwarding this to ASC by email, I also print a hard copy to be placed in our Alberta Room.

Kudos to our treasurer---she presented me with the financials for this past year (September 1, 2013-August 31, 2014) as well as the projected budget for our current year (September 1, 2014-August 31, 2015) at the memorial tournament in Calgary. Usually the above work has to be submitted by December, so I will be busy once it arrives. Because this is an election year for various positions on our provincial executive, I am also expected to submit this new listing. I often rely on our secretary for this information. Once these are sent, I require our treasurer to forward a copy of our provincial audit for the past year to our contact at Alberta Sports Connection. Next, our ASC contact schedules a meeting to discuss the information. Finally, I then have to get our president to sign the final form and trust our mail system to have it arrive on time as an original signature is required.

Steady progress has been made towards achieving our goals listed in our 3-5 year strategic plan. The Horseshoe Start-up package is close to completion and will then be available on the AHPA web site or from your Zone Director. The goal of hosting one interprovincial and one national in the next 5 years was met with the completion of the Canadian Championships in Calgary in August of 2014. The Membership Enhancement committee had completed their package and will be available on the AHPA website in the near future. Another goal deals with the formation of a provincial website. It is up and running. Information such as tournament schedules, membership enhancement, bylaws, newsletters, etc are in the plans to be able to access through the website. Youth participation increased during the past year, at the peewee and junior levels. We hope this will continue in the future.

Back to the survey and subsequent submissions of information. Once approved by Alberta Sports Connection, our grant is forwarded to us in 2 installments. For your information, the monies we receive from this grant are placed in our general revenue fund. We then have a break for the summer before all this commences again next fall.

We had 21 applications for bursaries this year which created a new problem for us as we only can give out 10. Two of the applications were incomplete and therefore not considered. The 19 remaining gave us lots of headaches as we tried to be as fair as we could in giving our decision. We decided that in the future we need to sit down with a few key people and figure out a criteria which will help us in deciding who to give these bursaries to. We finally decided to first consider first time applicants and people who applied last year and did not get one. Then we decided that if more than one applicant was from the same family we would give only one bursary. As we worked our way down the list we reconsidered people who had received a bursary last year until we finally got our 10 recipients.

5. Have a copy of our newsletter on the web page (it has all of the contacts for each club)bn

### ***2. Web Pages of Cities who have Active Clubs or Courts***

1. Have the contact name of President of Club, location and directions to the club under the recreation link of the city or town web/develop a web page for the club and ask the city to have a link to it on their web page
2. List the mission of the club and the past achievements of the club
3. What is the cost to join
4. Have dates and times club is open re: league play
5. Have dates and times of all tournaments at the club
6. Lind into the city's sports related web page

### **3. Individual Clubs**

1. Be listed with the local Chamber of Commerce and Municipal Office
  - Location of existing courts
  - Contact person
  - Dates and times of league play
  - Date of tournaments
2. Advertise the following ways for membership, tournaments:
  1. Local media- include local radio stations, community cable information channel, local newspapers( daily or weekly). Ensure information given to them if tournament held during town celebration eg fairs, Bentley Days
  2. Posters(to be developed)  
"Over 50" clubs,senior drop-ins, senior residential facilities(eg lodges)
  3. Schools- public, private, catholic
  4. Youth activities such as Girl Guides, Scouts, Boys and Girls Clubs
  5. Recreation Centers, arenas
  6. Schedule your club to have family days, over 50, bbq, lessons,etc
  7. Summer Camps
  8. Local Campsites
  9. Demonstration of sport at fairs, Mayors' Tea Party(local events). May use the portable pits for these
3. Be relevant to the specific group you are trying to attract. If you are trying to attract men and women with young families, then centring around children is relevant.
4. Once a new member joins or comes to play. Be positive, polite and attentive to them. Let them know the next event and personally invite them to come.
5. Networking is one of the most important things for a person or club to do. To start with it's important to maintain contact with you club's past members. Do this whether they have retired or resigned or relocated. These members have been there and done it, they can often be the best advertising for your club,as long as they are a positive influence to the club.
6. Build working relationships with other service clubs and community groups in your area: Lions Clubs, over 50, community associations. Build a relationship with other clubs in the association. It is not a competition between clubs our goal is to enhance memberships for AHPA and our individual Clubs.
7. List clubs in community directories.
8. Invite other clubs in the city to visit and play
9. Invite MLA's to play.
10. [www.civitan.org/clubsuccess.pdf](http://www.civitan.org/clubsuccess.pdf) is a how to manual for adding new members for club success. Form a committee and follow the manual.

**Note :**It is the responsibility of each affiliated club, not just the AHPA, to recruit new members.

If your club has other ideas that may assist in recruiting new members, please share with the Recruitment Committee or the executive of the AHPA.

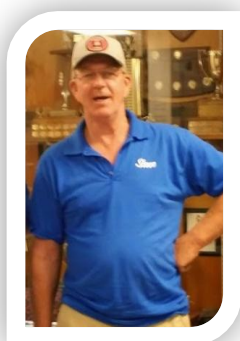
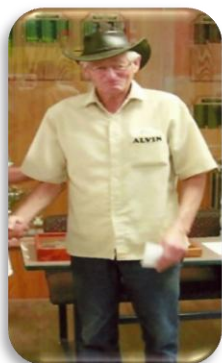

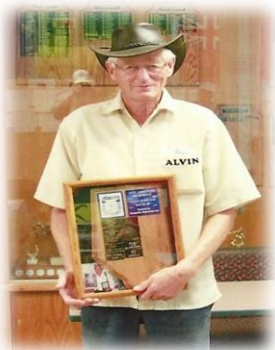
