OUT OF PROVINCE TRAVEL – PLAYERS ONLY

1. You must submit the following to the treasurer, Mary Holley:

a. Travel itinerary including date leaving home, date arriving at tournament, date leaving tournament location and date returning home.

b. If flying, require airline and flight details.

c. Where you will be staying while traveling to & from and while at the tournament.

d. How you will spend time while at the tournament when not playing – i.e. practice, scorekeeping, judging.

e. Estimated costs for travel

f. Estimated costs for accommodation/camping

2. Immediately after returning home you will need to submit a claim form with ALL receipts attached to the treasurer. The claim form will be available to those who submit travel itinerary and play in the tournaments. Gaming expects double occupancy for accommodation where possible.

3. If you plan to attend the Western Canada Classic, World Tournament or Canadians, and would like assistance with travel costs, the above must be followed in order to apply to Gaming to use Casino funds.

4. As per a motion at the AGM, Oct 3, 2015 - A player must enter a minimum of 4 tournaments in Alberta, one of which must be the Provincial Championships. Those tournaments will be counted from September 1, 2016 until the out-of-province travel date in 2017.

4. COMPLETED ITINERARIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE TREASURER BY MAY 21, 2017 TO BE CONSIDERED FOR TRAVEL ASSISTANCE IN 2017.

CRITERIA FOR CLUB IMPROVEMENTS FINANCIAL SUPPORT FROM AHPA

In order to receive AHPA financial assistance to improve or repair the horseshoe courts at your club, the following criteria is to be adhered to:

1. The club must be in good standing with the AHPA and host a sanctioned tournament yearly.

2. A letter confirming that the club has a long term plan and approval from the land owners to be presented with the request for assistance to the executive prior to starting the project.

3. All receipts for supplies and paid labour must be presented to the treasurer after the work is completed.

4. A list of volunteer hours with names and hours to be submitted with the receipts.

5. Any club doing minor repairs may submit receipts for items such as paint, rakes, shovels, sand, lumber etc. without prior approval. The executive will then review before reimbursement.

6. AHPA financial support is available to all clubs meeting these criteria. EXECUTIVE APPROVAL IS REQUIRED BEFORE ANY REIMBURSEMENTS TAKE PLACE.

7. Under new AGLC guidelines, a reciprocal agreement must be signed and in place prior to gaming funds being allocated to organizations within the province.

8. As per a motion at the 2016 AGM

ANY CLUB THAT RECEIVES OR HAS RECEIVED FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE AHPA MUST ENSURE THAT IF/WHEN THAT CLUB DISSOLVES THAT ALL ASSETS BE TURNED OVER TO THE AHPA FOR DISPERSAL OR DISTRIBUTION TO OTHER ACTIVE CLUBS.

The goal is for participants to try sports they may have an interest in joining in the future." Zone 4 Report

2016

Here we are near the end of another schedule of horseshoe pitching in both Zone 4 and within the AHPA. The weather was great this past summer- not one scheduled tournament was cancelled nor delayed due to inclement weather!

Our Zone 4 tournaments, which include Red Deer, Wetaskiwin, Ponoka, Bentley and Innisfail, were very well attended. Red Deer, Ponoka and Wetaskiwin hosted 2 days of singles while Bentley hosted one day of singles and one day of doubles and Innisfail hosted one day of singles. Unfortunately, Lougheed was unable to host a tournament this year. Potlucks were enjoyed at all of our tournaments other than Innisfail wwhere the participants were encouraged to partake of the buffet offered at the Innisfail Legion after play on Saturday.

As with other Zones within the AHPA, our numbers continue to fall. Although some clubs are experiencing the addition of new members, this only makes up for the members who have not rejoined. Numbers in other clubs continue to remain the same. Wetaskiwin had the addition of new 40 footers, 30 footers and juniorswell done! On the negative side, participation in some clubs is limited to a very small number of members.

Red Deer continues to work with various junior and senior high schools, with over 200 students participating with horseshoe pitching in their curriculum.

For the Alberta Open, the Bentley club graciously lent the Zone Flags to the AHPA to display at the tournament in Calgary. Many new members from clubs throughout the province had never seen these and were very impressed. Some expressed that they would like to see these at all Alberta tournaments!
