The Art of Horseshoe Pitching By Mryna Kissick

Horseshoe pitching is one of a few sports that is a lifetime sport. A person starts pitching at 9 years old and pitch all their life if they want to.

There have been people in their 90's pitching shoes at the Canadian Championships in Saskatchewan and a gentleman 92 years old placed 2^{nd} in his class.

It's a sport called the aerobic sport of sports. You use every muscle in your body. You stretch, walk, bend and throw a 1 ½ lb horseshoe 30 or 40 feet. You get a complete workout, laidback and easy. And you don't need anyone to be with you to get this workout, just go to the courts and start pitching. If you have a problem or something is bothering you, after pitching for awhile, you will feel much better. It's a very good sport for the mind and of course the body too.

If you beat upon the pegs it makes you feel good too and don't feel bad if you don't make ringers, remember you are there for exercise. The more you pitch the better you will get and you will make ringers.

Now comes the fun, tournaments, and yes tournaments ae fun. You get to test yourself against other pitchers, to see how good you are. Sometimes you win, sometimes you lose. You are put in the class according to your ringer percentage so you play people who are the same as you. So, it is as fair as possible. OK.

Yes, did I mention that the sport of horseshoes is one of the oldest sports. The Roman Soldiers played horseshoes. They used the shoes from their big war horses. Today the shoes are more modern. All they are used for is to pitch horseshoes. There are different styles out there. It's up to you what style suits you. That's just a little about the art of horseshoe pitching. There's lots more around.

I said there's different kinds of pitching shoes. They may be different in looks, but they all have the same weights and sizing. Heavy 2.10, Medium 2.9 and light 2.8. There are different ways of throwing the shoes. They are called, the flip, the turn and a quarter, the turn and three quarter and the

quarter turn. These are the most popular. All of these throws have to be learned. A lot of 30 footers throw the flip. Some of the 40 footers do too. The turn and a quarter is very popular as well. The flip is the easiest.

And next is the stance. How the feet are placed before the shoe is thrown. A few people don't step or stride, they stand and throw the shoe. But most people take a stride when they throw the shoe, this helps to release the shoe with the forward swing.

Balance is very important in horseshoe pitching. Also, concentration is very important as well. It's a mind game. It's a good game for sharpening the mind and the body as well. It's also a fun game. It's a relaxed and laid-back game. Most of the people who play against each other are friends and acquaintances, so the game is friendly and fun. Most campgrounds have horseshoe courts. It's a popular game for campers. A lot of people play horseshoes who don't belong to a horseshoe club or play in tournaments. They play because it's a fun game and doesn't cost a lot of money and yes horseshoes is a sport that's very easy on the pocket book. The most cost is the shoes and they last a long time and not too many will break. The shoes are about all that is needed to play. The people who belong to clubs and play in tournaments have more tools, pick up sticks, and measuring tools, along with their shoes. The measuring tools and pick up sticks don't cost much so as I said horseshoe pitching is very easy sport to get into money wise.

Horseshoe pitching is an outdoor sport, but there is a big indoor horseshoe court in Calgary. The only one of its kind in Canada. The lucky pitchers in Calgary pitch all year long. They have winter tournaments plus league play all winter. The sport of horseshoe pitching in Alberta is very lucky to have this facility. Also, the Alberta Horseshoe Pitching Association have portable courts. They can be moved from place to place. They can be rented or used for clubs that want to use the courts. The courts are in a trailer so are easy to move.

Remember, horseshoe pitching is a fun game and excellent way to stay in shape.

All adults must have pitched in a minimum of two (2) US/Canadian sanctioned events in the twelve (12) months prior to June 8th, 2021, in the same division you are entering. Only one (1) event is required for Juniors. Exceptions for US Armed Forces members and family and foreign competitors (other than Canadians) are outlined in Rule 11, Sec D.1 of the RGS Book. Contact NHPA for more information regarding qualifying exceptions. All averages used will be the average on record in eShoe/ CANSTATS as of June 8th, 2021. Anyone qualifying under an exception must have those scores recorded by the same date. All NHPA and any special tournament rules apply. NHPA and CANADIAN entrants must provide identification by sanction card, or other form of ID, when checking in. Please see note regarding refunds.
