TRAVEL ASSISTANCE FROM AHPA 2025

Please read the following guidelines carefully. As AHPA members, please help make every event fun and successful.

World Tournament assistance will be for players only based on the criteria:

- 1. Must complete 4 AHPA sanctioned tournaments (1 of which must be the Provincial Championships) These tournaments must be between Sept 1, 2024 and the date you leave for Sandy, Utah.
- 2. Must submit a completed itinerary to Mike Holley or Ross Stevenson by noon May 18, 2025.
- 3. Must travel to and from Sandy, Utah by the most direct route. Fuel receipts may be submitted for travel from home to the closest airport and back home by the most direct route. Fuel receipts for those driving must be only from home to Sandy and back home. No assistance will be allowed for fuel used for sight-seeing.
- 4. Must complete the tournament.
- 5. Fuel or airfare receipts must be submitted. Car rental must be receipted and submitted.
- 6. The number of nights accommodation will be approved as per AGLC rules. There is a maximum of \$150 CDN per night.
- 7. Payment will be based on receipts submitted after travel that meet with the approval of AGLC and fit within the AHPA budget. The number of nights would generally be number of days playing plus one. For those driving one stop overnight in each direction is usually approved.
- 8. All receipts must be attached to a sheet of 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" paper with tape unless the receipt is an 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11" paper.
- 9. All claims with receipts must be to the president by August 15, 2025.

Canadian Championships assistance will be for players only.

- 1. Must compete in 4 AHPA sanctioned tournaments (1 must be the Provincial Championships). These tournaments must be between Sept 1, 2024, and the date you leave to travel to Saint-Joseph-de-Sorel, QC.
- 2. A completed itinerary must be submitted to Mike Holley or Ross Stevenson by noon June 21, 2025.
- 3. Must travel to and from Saint-Joseph-de-Sorel by the most direct route.
- 4. All fuel or airfare or car rental receipts must be submitted.

- 5. The number of nights accommodation will be approved as per AGLC rules. The maximum per night is \$150.
- 6. The claim forms will be provided at the end of the tournament.
- 7. Total claims must not exceed the AHPA 2025 budget or the AGLC pre-approved amount.
- 8. All receipts must be attached to a sheet of paper that is 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 11". Do not hi-lite on the receipts. It will not photocopy. Remember all receipts are submitted to AGLC for review.
- 9. Players must complete the tournament they enter to qualify for the claim.
- 10. All claims with receipts must be to Mike Holley or Ross Stevenson by August 25, 2025.

Provincial Championship, AB Open, Western Canada Classic and Fall Memorial will be treated as in-province travel as in previous years.

- 1. 2 nights accommodation (maximum of \$150 per night). Some exceptions may allow 3 nights.
- 2. Fuel based on receipts.
- 3. Completed claim forms submitted by deadline of July 5 for Provincials; June 8 for the Alberta Open, July 13 for the Western Canada Classic and September 30 for the Fall Memorial with all receipts attached to an $8 \frac{1}{2} \times 11$ sheet of paper. No photos! Scanned pdf or originals only.
- 4. Players must travel the most direct route to and from the tournament.
- 5. Players must complete each tournament that they enter.
- 6. The minimum of 100 km. has been eliminated from the travel assistance policy.


